

**Failure to Develop Initial Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI)
by the deadline of October 16, 2024
& Failure to Report the Initial LSLI to the State**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Deadline & Reporting Requirement Not Met for Las Colinas Water Plant

We were required to develop and submit to the State an initial Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) that includes all service lines connected to the public water distribution system and characterize the materials of those service lines as either lead, galvanized requiring replacement, non-lead, or lead status unknown. The initial Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) determined that there were **no lead service lines** found in the system.

Our system failed to complete this initial Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) by the October 16, 2024 deadline, resulting in a violation. It was actually completed in January 2025.

In addition, our system failed to submit the initial Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) to the State by the October 16, 2024 deadline, resulting in a reporting violation.

Although, the failure to submit the LSLI by the deadline and the failure to report the initial LSLI to the State and the EPA does not create a risk to public health, we are required to inform you of these violations and provide additional information including what we did to correct the situation.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other actions.

Remember, no lead service lines were found in the system.

What is being done?

We completed the initial Lead Service Line Inventory (LSLI) in January 2025 and submitted the inventory to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) on May 2026. The EPA has also been notified.

This Public Notice will be posted on the Las Colinas website. A notification of this posting will be included on customers' monthly water bills.
